APPLICATION DEADLINES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fall semester : June 1st - Spring semester : November 1st
APPLICATION DOCUMENTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A nomination letter/e-mail from the home school; - The application form filled and signed ; - An art portfolio (5 to 10 pages, 20 MO max) ; - A letter of motivation of the applicant presenting a short description of his/her current artistic work, explains why he/she wants to study at Beaux-Arts de Paris and specify the studio that he/she wishes to join ; - A resume ; - A copy of the passport ; - A photo (<i>jpeg - ID format suitable for a student card</i>)
N.B.	<u>Except for the photo, all documents should be sent in PDF format and under a suitable title specifying the name and type of document (eg: NAME_portfolio)</u>
LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT	No minimum, but it is advised to have some notions of French - we recommend B1. NB: Theoretical courses are taught in French.
SELECTION PROCESS	After receiving the applications, Beaux-Arts de Paris organizes a selection committee - the applicants will receive an e-mail confirming their acceptance to the school 3 weeks after the application deadline.

GRADING SYSTEM & TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The Beaux-Arts study programme follows a curriculum based on the European Credit Transfer System (E.C.T.S.) - Pass or Fail : Beaux-Arts de Paris does not provide grades or marks
FRENCH LESSONS	French as a Foreign Language lessons (3 hours per week) are mandatory for the non French-speaking students during their whole exchange semester.
